**Review Below Information Carefully:** \*If you are selected for an Officer position, you must provide the following:

-An official transcript from the university. (Must be mailed to this organization--we cannot accept a student issued copy.)

-Resume of military and civilian experience.

\*You will be scheduled to take a complete physical and complete the necessary paperwork for commissioning.

·If selected, you will be required to take a *Drug Test* during your physical processing!

·If selected for a Pilot position, you will be required to complete a Medical Flight Screening at Brooks AFB, TX, in addition to our unit's physical.

\***Non-prior service** officers will be required to first *enlist*, and then attend the Academy of Military Science (AMS) for 6 weeks.

**\*Pilot(s)** (Non-Prior Service) must take the Basic Attributes Test (BATS) for dexterity and agility.

*Test takes approximately 1 ½ hours. Available time for test taking is 0800 – 1700 hours, Monday thru Friday.*

**\*Professionals** (Doctors, Nurses, Lawyers, Chaplains): Are not required to attend AMS; however, a 4-week Professional Course (Commissioned Officer Training {COT} is mandatory). Duration of course is 4 weeks and can be broken down into two-two week increments.

**\*Prior Service Officers** - Must be ready to provide at least last three copies of their Officer Performance Reports (OPR's), most current Record Review Listing, copy of last physical (specifically SF 88 & SF 93), Flying records (if applicable), appointment and Promotion order, DD 214 and any other separation document(s).

If currently assigned to an active military unit, a conditional release must be initiated by you & signed/approved by proper authority.

\*Officers represent approximately 10% of our base populace. A selection board will consider applicants. Each applicant will be given equal opportunity to be considered for a commission in the 182d Airlift Wing, without regard to race, gender or religion. The unit commander will be the final approving authority. You will be notified of your selection or non-selection in writing.
