



## **Military OneSource Free Tax Filing Services**

Tax season is right around the corner, and so are Military OneSource tax filing services. Beginning Jan. 8, 2013, eligible service and family members have access to Military OneSource tax consultants and have the ability to complete, save and file federal and state tax returns through the H&R Block At Home<sup>®</sup> tool free of charge.

### **EFILING PREPARATION**

In preparation for filing your tax return, you should begin to gather all the necessary tax documents and additional information such as:

- Social Security numbers and birthdates for all members of your family
- education, child care and any adoption expenses
- W-2 forms from any and all employers
- investment income forms
- alimony information
- Social Security benefits
- miscellaneous income
- Form 1098-E documenting student loan interest
- Form 1098 documenting mortgage interest
- receipts for charitable donations
- proof of health related expenses
- real estate tax information
