REQUIREMENTS FOR NON-RATED ALO POSITIONS 19ZXB: If not currently commissioned, must complete the Total Force Officer Training (TFOT) at Maxwell AFB, AL (8 weeks). Follow on courses include: Special Warfare Preparation Course, TACP Prep Course, SERE Course, Basic Airborne School, Basic ALO Skills Course (BASC), and JTAC Qualification Course.
