Follow on courses include: Special Warfare Preparation Course, TACP Basic Skills Course, SERE Course, Basic Airborne School, TACP Formal Training Unit (FTU), Basic ALO Skills Course (BASC). Total follow-on training time required is approximately one year from final pipeline course completion.

REQUIREMENTS FOR RATED ALO POSITIONS (11FX/11BX/12FX/12BX/13BX): Must be a rated pilot/navigator from a fighter/bomber aircraft or Air Battle Manager (13BX) with one of the following specialty shreds: B (AWACS), D (Mobile Air Control), K (JSTARS) or U (Air Liaison Officer).
